### **2015 Adult Group Learn to Sail Program on Portage Lake**

Five meetings, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, from 6:30-8:30pm for three weeks (10 hours of instruction)

Session 1 – June 9, 10, 16, 17, 23

Session 2 – July 7, 8, 14, 15, 21

This class is designed for adults who are interested in learning a fun and exciting on-the-water activity. Students will learn to sail on their own on a Laser Pico that is quick and easy to rig and learn. Students will also spend time sailing with other students on a Hobie Wave, and on either an Interlake or Flying Scot. Additionally, students will be introduced to sailboat racing as they take a pontoon boat ride with their instructor to view an evening race on Portage Lake.

### 2015 Adult Group Learn to Sail Program on Portage Lake

***"Your new hobby/sport/passion..."***

Five meetings, 2X per week for three weeks

Tuesday and Wednesday 6:30-8:30pm

Tuesday	Introduction to the club and our fleet. Swim test. Wind direction. Parts of the sailboat. Safety, basic knots, rigging a Flying Scot. Sail trim. Sail the Scot, tiller time for each student, tack, jibe, practice.
Wednesday	Wind direction/exiting the harbor. Rigging a Pico. Review parts of a sailboat. Sail trim. 'Irons'. Sculling. 'Follow the leader' in the Picos. Capsize practice near a sandbar. Returning to harbor.
Tuesday	Pico practice. Sail to a mark (one race mark set early for our practice) and back to the club. Introduction/rigging the Hobie Wave. Alternate sailing the Picos and the wave (man overboard practice).
Wednesday	Sailing a Scot or Interlake Crew work Flying the spinnaker
Tuesday	Pico practice. Final hour today will be a pontoon boat ride for a live commentary on the race rules and procedures for the single handed race taking place.
Wednesday	Practice/sailing games/mini-race in Picos.
